The draw would be held on the first Saturday of the month

Numbers would be allocated on a first come first served basis

A rolling system could be operated – if you join in January you are in the draw till December. If you joined in May you would be in the draw until the following April. We would prefer to start the system once all numbers have been filled.

The proceeds generated by The Forty-Nine Club would be solely accumulated for the use of Health Issues in the Basset Hound and a special Bank Account would be opened entirely separate from the normal Club Funds.
